Objectives:

- Promoting a culture of inclusion and integration;
- Promoting the values of socialization and solidarity, respect for the dignity of others and the principle of equal opportunities;
- Promoting the art for educational and cultural purposes, as a tool for implementing European values of "interculturality" and the active participation of young people.
- Improving the quality of socio-educational animation including through a closer cooperation between organizations that work in the youth field.
- Increasing the international dimension of activities in the field of youth and increasing the capacity of youth workers and youth organizations such as support for young.

The proposal for the exchange will last 24 months maximum.

Expected results:

- The creation of an interactive platform for the virtual exchange between partners, groups of young people involved and the construction of a network of stakeholders.
- The organization of an International Workshop for training and exchanging of experiences among the operators partners.
- The organization of an International Workshop for the exchange of youth groups involved.
- The realization of an Out-put in the form of E-Report containing the exchanged material and final documents.
- The organization of local events and advertising materials for the promotion and dissemination of the objectives and results of the exchange programme.
